

Yorktown Golf and Baseball Center Field Trip Rules and Guidelines

Thank you for choosing Yorktown Golf & Baseball. We kindly suggest the following preparations for your visit:

Mini Golf:

Divide your group into smaller teams. Each team will start on a different hole and will play through until everyone plays 18 holes (*Players starting on 1 finish on hole 18, players starting on hole 2 finish on hole 1, etc*). This allows everyone to begin playing at once and avoids wait times. Each group will receive 1-2 putters to share. Each player will receive a mini golf ball. Please be sure to collect all balls and putters and return them to the cashier.

Batting Cages:

We will give you batting cage tokens that you will distribute to your group. Helmets and bats are complimentary and will be distributed to your group. **Only 1 person in the cage at a time. Helmets are mandatory. The minimum age to use the batting cage is 7 years old - no exceptions!** Please be sure to remind your group to stand behind the line designating the batting box for their safety.

Driving Range:

We will reserve a portion of the tee line for your group. Range balls and clubs will be provided. **Only one person is allowed in the driving range bay at a time - anyone else who is not hitting must remain behind the green poles for their safety.**

Upon arrival, have your group meet under the Event Tent. If the event tent is not available, we will provide your group with further instructions on where to meet. After your group arrives, please have a chaperone/representative of your group remit payment at the cashier before we direct you to your activities. We require there is at least one chaperone present at each activity to supervise and ensure safety precautions are being followed.

If you have multiple activities planned, you will be responsible for keeping track of time to switch between activities and ensure adequate time is given at each activity.

Chips, drinks, and ice cream may be purchased inside the office. As this is a small space, to minimize crowding, a maximum of 5 students and one chaperone are allowed inside at a time.

General Guidelines:

- ★ We require a 10:1 student-chaperone ratio.
- ★ Please have your group remain within their designated activity areas
- ★ No swinging of clubs, bats, or putters outside of the designated hitting area
- ★ No running or horseplay

Please be mindful that failure to follow rules and/or safety precautions may result in your group being asked to leave without a refund. Have fun - but please keep in mind it is a shared space & we have a responsibility to create a fun and safe environment for *all* of our patrons.
